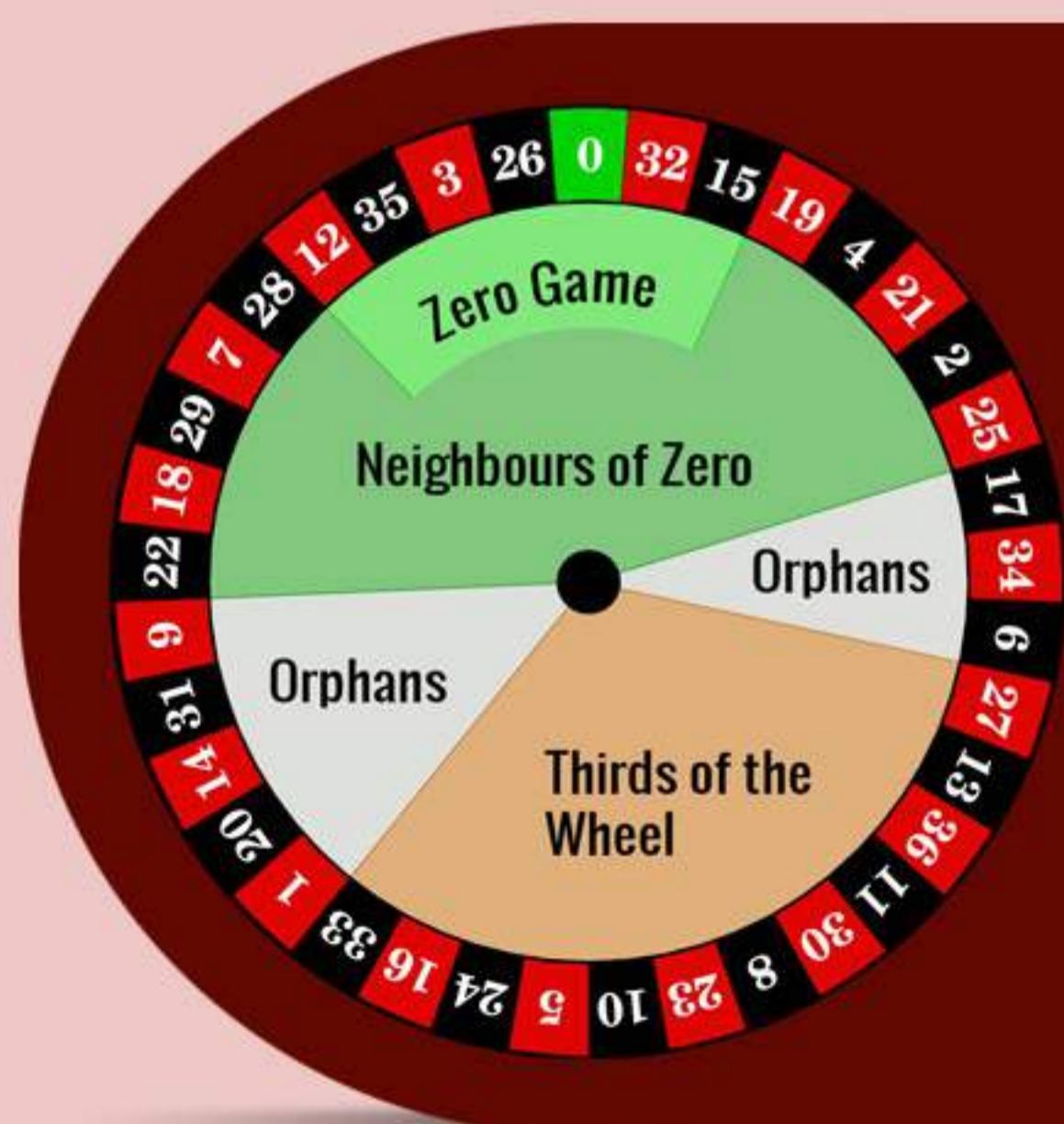

European Table Layout

The European roulette wheel is split up between a series of even and odd, red and black spaces. It also has one green zero space. The wheel has spaces for numbers from 0 to 36 and players can place a variety of bets depending on what he believes the wheel will stop on. The major difference between the American layout and the European one is the European layout has a single 0 space and more favorable odds for players.

American Table Layout

The American table is setup almost identically to the European layout, but it has a 0 and a 00 spot that doubles the casinos edge, making it a more difficult variant to win.



EUROPEAN BETS

Inside Roulette Bets

STRAIGHT UP - A bet on a single number.

SPLIT - A two number bet.

TRIPLE - A bet that covers the number 0, 1, 2 or 00, 2, 3.

STREET - A three number bet.

CORNER (SQUARE) - A bet on 4 numbers.

FIVE NUMBER - A bet that covers 5 numbers 0, 00, 1, 2, 3.

SIX LINE - A bet that covers 6 numbers or two lines.

Outside Roulette Bets

COLUMN BETS - A bet on 12 numbers on any of three lines on the roulette table (Like as 1st line, 1 - 4 - 7 - 10 and down to 34). The chip is to be placed on the square below the last number in the line.

DOZEN BETS - A bet on either the first (1 - 12), second (13 - 24) or third (25 - 34) twelve numbers.

RED/BLACK - A bet that the number will be either red or black.

EVEN/ODD - A bet on odd or even numbers.

LOW/HIGH - A bet that the ball will land on one of the low or high 18 numbers (1 to 18 or 19 - 26).mbers or two lines.

There are a variety of bets that can be placed on a European wheel and it's important to understand what those bets mean. There are many straightforward options like betting on one specific number on the wheel, or on red or black, or even or odd, but there are also more confusing and technical bets that experienced players rely on. For instance, a Street is a bet that covers three consecutive numbers on the wheel. The table above explains the different bets that you can make, and the European Table Layout chart splits up the different numbers based on many of the bets that you can make as well.
